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

Cloud Compliance and audit – drivers and challenges



While cloud accelerated IT processes, it amplified audit challenges



- Only 20% of 50+ customers report they have some automation to collect audit data (AWS survey)
- Most Governance, Risk, and Compliance teams spend up to 60% of their time just collecting data (AWS Survey)
- Only 14% of Chief Audit Executives say they provide assurance on risk from disruptive innovation (IIA OnRisk Study)



What is AWS Audit Manager?

Service to continuously audit your AWS usage



Enables internal audit & governance, risk, and compliance (GRC) teams

Offers pre-built, customizable frameworks to map usage to controls

Automates collection & organization of evidence across accounts

Enables delegation, comments, control status updates, and notifications to help collaborate across teams

Produces assessment reports with evidence integrity checks
